6.1 Point of Order	No	No	None	Yes	Protest breach of Rules or conduct
6.2 Point of Information	No	No	None	No	Ask any rules or general clarification question of the chair.
6.3 Point of Privilege	No	No	None	No	Ask a question Pertaining to personal comfort at the meeting.
6.4 Point of Inquiry	No	No	None	No	Ask a question of a speaker at the end of their speech prior to their yielding the floor.
7.1 Suspension of the Meeting	Yes	No	Majority	No	Recess the meeting for a specific period of time – often for caucusing.
7.2 Adjournment of the Meeting	Yes	No	Majority	No	End the meeting for the year.
7.3 Adjournment of Debate	Yes	2 Pro / 2 Con	Majority	No	Has the effect of tabling any issue open to debate without a vote on the content of that issue
7.4 Closer of Debate on Agenda Topic	Yes	2 Con	Majority	No	Put all Resolutions that has been considered to a vote
7.5 Closer of Debate	Yes	2 Con	Majority	No	Ends debate on any issue, resolution or amendment open to debate and bring it to an immediate vote.
7.6 Appeal a Decision of the Chair	Yes	2 Pro / 2 Con	$\frac{2}{3}$ Majority	No	Challenge a ruling made by the chair.
7.7 Decision of Competence	Yes	2 Pro / 2 Con	Majority	No	Question whether the UN body is competent to act on a certain issue within the Charter and international law.
7.8 Change the Order of Consideration of Agenda Items	Yes	No	Majority	No	Change the order in which agenda items are discussed.
7.9 Limits on Debate	Yes	2 Pro / 2 Con	Majority	No	Impose (or repeal) a limit on the length or frequency of any form of debate.
7.10 Division of the Question	Yes	2 Pro / 2 Con	Majority	No	Proposing that part of an amendment or resolution be voted on separately
7.11 Consideration of Amendments	Yes	No	None	No	Bring an amendment to the floor for discussion.
7.12 Reconsideration of Proposals	Yes	2 Con	Varies	No	Reconsider an item on which debate has been adjourned or opens which a vote has been taken.
7.13 Important Question	Yes	2 Pro / 2 Con	Majority	No	Only in GA Plenary session; signifies that a resolution or amendment requires $\frac{2}{3}$ majority vote for passage.
7.14 Change the Order of Consideration of Resolutions	Yes	No	Majority	No	Consider a resolution, other than the next one in order under the agenda item.
