6.1 Point of Order	No	No	None	Yes	Protest breach of Rules or conduct
6.2 Point of Information	No	No	None	No	Ask any rules or general clarification question of the chair.
6.3 Point of Privilege	No	No	None	No	Ask a question Pertaining to personal comfort at the meeting.
6.4 Point of Inquiry	No	No	None	No	Ask a question of a speaker at the end of their speech prior to their yielding the floor.
7.1 Suspension of the Meeting	Yes	No	Majority	No	Recess the meeting for a specific period of time – often for caucusing.
7.2 Adjournment of the Meeting	Yes	No	Majority	No	End the meeting for the year.
7.3 Adjournment of Debate	Yes	2 Pro / 2 Con	Majority	No	Has the effect of tabling any issue open to debate <i>without</i> a vote on the content of that issue
7.4 Closer of Debate on Agenda Topic	Yes	2 Con	Majority	No	Brings all Resolutions that has been moved to the floor to a vote
7.5 Closer of Debate	Yes	2 Con	Majority	No	Ends debate on any issue, resolution or amendment open to debate and bring it to an immediate vote.
7.6 Appeal a Decision of the Chair	Yes	2 Pro / 2 Con	$\frac{2}{3}$ Majority	No	Challenge a ruling made by the chair.
7.7 Enter Consultative Session	Yes	2 Pro / 2 Con	Majority	No	A less formal and open session of security council where open dialog can be conducted.
7.8 Add an Agenda Topic	Yes	2 Pro / 2 Con	Majority	No	Add topic to agenda.
7.9 Change the Order of Consideration of Working Agenda	Yes	No	Majority	No	Change the order in which agenda items are discussed.
7.10 Set Working Agenda	Yes	2 Pro / 2 Con	Majority	No	Order in which topics will be discussed.
7.11 Limits on Debate	Yes	2 Pro / 2 Con	Majority	No	Impose (or repeal) a limit on the length or frequency of any form of debate.
7.12 Division of the Question	Yes	2 Pro / 2 Con	Majority	No	Proposing that part of an amendment or resolution be voted on separately
7.13 Bring Resolution to the Floor	No	No	None	No	Bring a resolution to the floor for discussion.
7.14 Bring Amendment to the Floor	No	No	None	No	Bring an amendment to the floor for discussion.
7.15 Party to the Dispute	Yes	2 Pro / 2 Con	Majority	No	Ask that an outside source be permitted to address the body. SC needs to address what privileges that the outside group will have.
